This person can be referred by their doctor to Occupational Therapy Vocational Services to be evaluated to participate in a variety of individualized or group programs to assist a person in achieving their return to school or work goals. The Work Readiness Program is designed to help individuals who do not know what type of work they can do, explore their current work skills, interests, and tolerances through hands-on participation in various work-related and vocational tests. The goal of the program is to help individuals know if they are ready to go to school, a training program, or work and help them identify the steps needed to reach their goal.
